NOUVEL and the SANS Institute bring CISSP Exam Preparation to Geneva in November

(Geneva, Switzerland) Aug 2, 2010. The SANS Institute will be in Switzerland for the "SANS Geneva CISSP at HEG" event, 15-20 November. The "SANS +S™ Training Program for the CISSP Certification Exam" is designed to prepare you to pass the exam. This course is an accelerated review course that assumes the student has a basic understanding of networks and operating systems and focuses solely on the ten domains of knowledge as determined by the International Information System Security Certification Consortium (ISC2).

Each domain of knowledge is dissected into its critical components. Every component is discussed showing its relationship to each other and other areas of network security. After completion of the course the student will have a good working knowledge of the ten domains of knowledge.

Over the past 18 months, 98% of all respondents, who studied our SANS® +S Training Program for the CISSP Certification Exam and then took the exam passed; compared to a national average of around 70% for other prep courses.

Note: The CISSP exam is NOT provided as part of the training.
